# Pattern for Chunky Scalloped Blanket by Happy Handicrafts



# Description

This chunky, scalloped blanket is a perfect project for crochet beginners. It will help develop the beginner skills of the single and double crochet stitch, while resulting in a beautiful, cozy blanket. The design is deceptively simple, as it works up into a lacey, scalloped edged piece that is certain to be treasured.

Although the pattern is designed to create a blanket approximately 52" x 60", you can modify the size by increasing the length of the foundation row (in multiples of 4 stitches) and by crocheted as far as you like beyond the 60".

#### **Materials**

- 10 skeins (1370 yards) of bulky weight yarn (5) I used <u>Lion Brand Hue & Me in charcoal</u> in the video.
- 6.5mm (K) crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

### Pattern

Row 1: CH 140. Work this foundation chain fairly loosely.

Row 2: DC in the 3rd CH from the hook, CH 2, SC in the next CH. \*Skip 2 CH, 2 DC in the next CH, CH 2, SC in the following CH. Repeat from \* across row, turn. You should now have 174 stitches.

Row 3 - 61: CH 2, skip the first stitch, make 2 DC, 2 CH, and 1 SC in the chain space. \*skip next 3 stitches and make (2 DC, 2 CH, and 1 SC in the chain space). Repeat from \* across row, turn.

Finish off your work and weave in ends.
