Pattern for Crocheted Baby Shoes by Happy Handicrafts

Description

These tiny crocheted shoes are so cute and sweet! They work up very quickly, and can be ready as a gift for the next baby shower in one short evening. Using the yarn and hook suggested, they end up measuring 3.5" to 4" in length, which is about equivalent to 0-3 months in size.

Materials

- 1 skein of medium or worsted weight yarn
- Crochet Hook, Size 4 mm
- Tapestry needle and Scissors
- Embellishments (Rhinestones, Satin Bows, Ribbon Rose Flowers)

Pattern - The Bottom of the Shoe

Row 1 - CH 10, SC in 2nd CH from hook, 1 SC in the next 7 CH, 5 SC in last CH. Working back from the other side of the CH, 1 SC in the next 7 CH, 2 SC in last CH. Sl St into first stitch of the row. (22 stitches)

Row 2 - CH 2, HDC in the same stitch, 1 HDC in the next 7 stitces, 2 HDC in next 5 stitches, 1 HDC in the next 7 stitches, 2 HDC in the last 2 stitches. Finish row with a Sl St to the beginning stitch. (30 stitches)

Row 3 - CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 1 HDC in the next 12 stitches, 1 HDC in the next 12 stitches, 2 HDC in the last 2 stitches. Finish the row with a Sl St to the first stitch of the row. (36 stitches)

Pattern - The Side and Toe of the Shoe

Row 4 - CH 2, 1 HDC all around. Finish the row with a Sl St. (36 stitches)

Row 5 - CH 2, 1 HDC in each stitch all around. Finish the row with a Sl St. (36 stitches)

Row 6 - CH 2, 1 HDC in next 11 stitches, DC2TOG 6 times, 1 HDC in last 12 stitches. Finish the row with a Sl St.

Row 7 - 1 SC in next 10 stitches, DC2TOG 4 times, 1 SC in last 9 stitches. Finish the row with a Sl St. Tie off, weave in ends, and apply embellishments if desired.
